Standard Operating Guidelines**

GROUP MEMBERSHIP

1. Must be a member of STS.
2. Must own or have available their own ATV.
3. Must pass an authorized ATV course.

GROUP LEADERSHIP

1. Group Leader will be elected each year by a majority vote of the group. Vote will be held by secret ballot.
2. These SOGs will be maintained by the Group Leader
3. Any changes to these SOGs will be approved by a majority of the group members.

OPERATOR GUIDELINES

4. ATV operators will wear an approved helmet on all missions and trainings.
5. ATV operators will wear eye protection.
6. ATV operators and passengers will wear appropriate footwear.
7. ATV operators will be properly dressed for the assignment.

EQUIPMENT LIST

8. The following is standard equipment that shall be carried on all ATVs on all missions and trainings.
 - a. Gloves
 - b. whistle
 - c. Knife
 - d. Pencil and paper
 - e. flashlight
 - f. Space blanket
 - g. Spare spark plugs
9. The following is standard equipment that shall be carried on each ATV team on all missions and trainings.

- h. Tool kit
 - i. Tow strap
 - j. First Aid Kit
10. The following is recommended in addition to the standard equipment.
- a. FRS radio with sub channels.
 - b. Radio with SAR frequencies
 - c. HAM license
 - d. Water
 - e. Spare fuel
 - f. Food and/or energy bars
 - g. Tarp
 - h. Binoculars
 - i. Map
 - j. Compass
 - k. GPS
 - l. Flagging tape and permanent marker
 - m. Extra batteries & bulb for flashlight
 - n. Spotlight
 - o. Fire starters
 - p. Axe
 - q. Bug Repellant
 - r. Air compressor
 - s. Tire repair kit
